The branch in **Perú** came from three spanish brothers – Bonifacio, José y Saturio Andújar Cepa – who arrived when they were 15 years old. They were attracted by the wealthy of Cerro de Pasco mines (peruvian Andes), the most high mining city over the world. The first brother to come was Bonifacio my direct great parent. He arrived in october 1875.

I've investigated and wrote some articles showing their roots came from a small and beautiful town called *San Breixo de Lamas, La Estrada*, Galicia, Spain. I visited the village and founded so many Andujars over there. The ancient graveyard and chapel books are plenty of data about the family.

The three brothers' parents were *Ignacio Andújar Paseiro* and Nicanora Cepa. I discovered that Ignacio and his five brothers – Ignacio, Eusebio, Ramón, Juan y Fernando - studied law and philosophy at Universidad Santiago de Compostela around 1850. I have all kind of documents about that period.

At presente time my elder brother –José- is settled in USA and my young sister Pilar lives in Spain. Ricardo and I are keeping on here in Peru.

I would like to know about others branches of the family. José (Bonifacio's brother) founded a little one in Costa Rica. I'm in touch with them. I think the most ancient and spread root could be in Galicia. Although, I heard so much about one in Puerto Rico.
